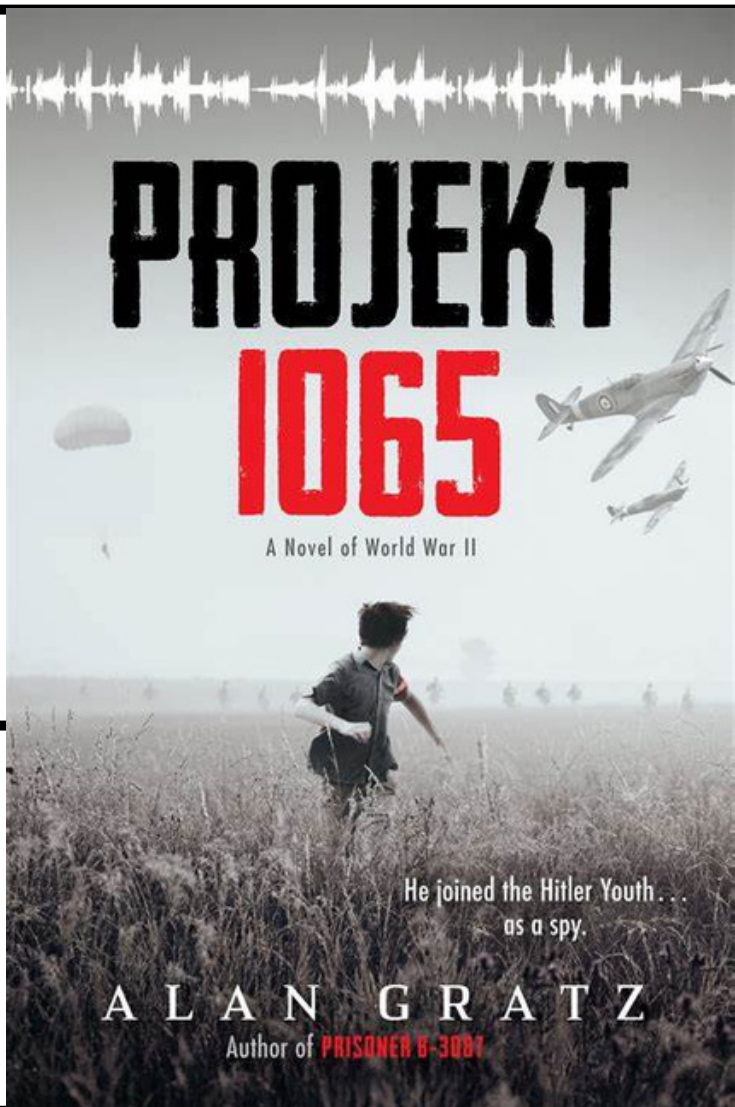

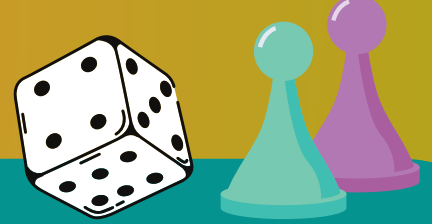
Projekt 1065 is an overall well written book. With cliffhangers at every turn, Gratz catches your attention and makes you want to read the whole book in one sitting. The book does have some scenes that might be scary to younger readers, but is overall a good read for anyone. It is about Michael, who is a kid spy for the allies in Germany. He faces tough decisions at every corner, but always stays strong.



One of these snakes is a copperhead and one is a non-venomous water snake. Can you tell the difference? The most noticeable difference is the copperhead has "Hershey kiss" shaped bands. The water snake has more stripe-like bands. A less noticeable difference is that the copperhead has "cat eyes" and the water snake has normal looking eyes. Now can you tell the difference?

Note: A water snake is non-venomous but will still bite you. It also has an anti-coagulant in its saliva that will make you bleed for longer than normal. Stay cautious about both!

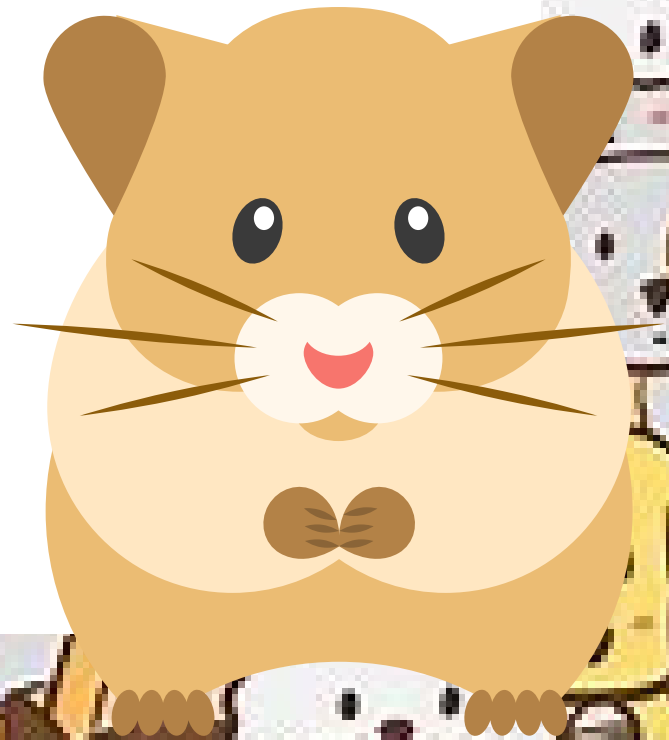

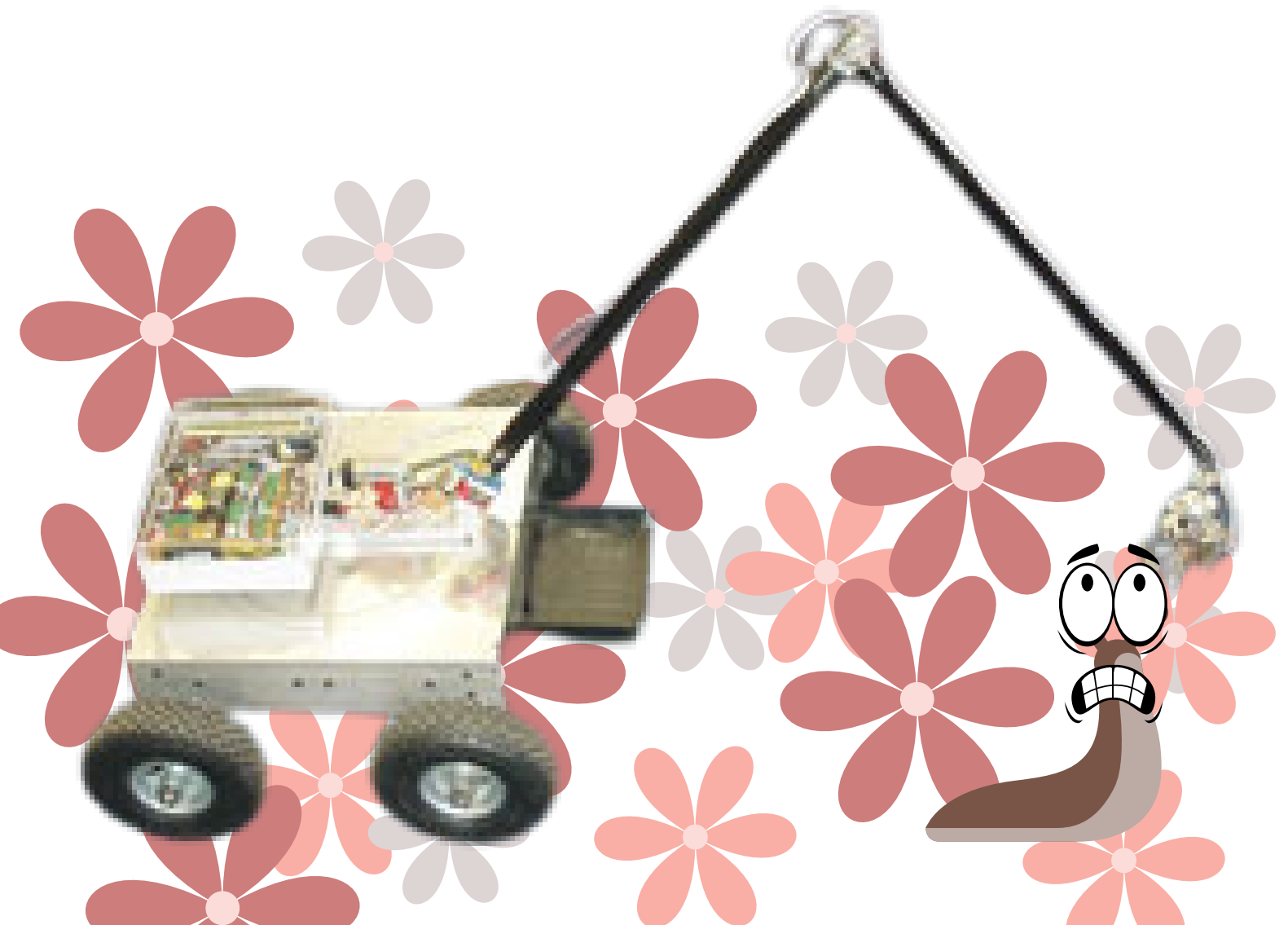

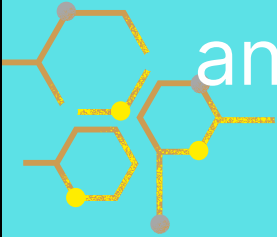


Rocket League is a fun game for all ages. The concept of the game is basically playing soccer with racecars.
